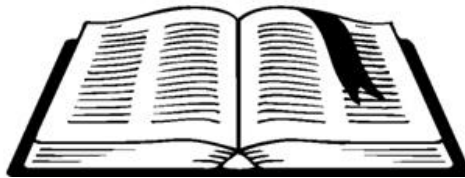
IN THE BEGINNING
