The identification of the underlying (implied) problem or contradiction to which John is actually responding.

IHOPers' Reflections: Individuals who are not helpful.</p>	<p>Vss. 3 and 4, WS: Faithfulness to the Truth which always is experienced as At-One-Ment. We are called to continue to walk in this Truth. The issue here is sanctification, or how do we live the Awakened Life? IHOPers' Reflections: There is tension between Gaius and Diotrephes. If we are to talk the talk we must also walk the walk.</p>	<p>Vss. 11, WS: The imitation of Evil - those who practice the principles of an illusion of reality (evil) have not seen The Really Real, the evidence of Perfect At-One-Ment. IHOPers' Reflections: We are victims. We experience this in the current TV ads where all men are dumb caricatures of real men.</p>
