THE DEEP DRILLING FORMAT

The format is based on Imaginal Education principles. Its focus is on “spatial understanding” instead of “lineral understanding” is deductive, the process of adding words, lines, paragraphs together to make the idea whole. "Spatial understanding" is an inductive process in which broad scope of the material in intuited, and we are allowed to enter into a dialogue with the author. To do this effectively, note the following ways to access this chart "spatially".

I. Just the facts, please (Objective Level)

The bottom three lines (A-B-C), include the [A] the scripture references, [B] my numbering of the sections in the NIV (#1 "The Word Became Flesh" 1:1-18 NIV); #2 "John the Baptist Denies Being the Christ" 1:19-34 NIV); etc. Then those sections labeled [C] are my summary of the significance of the material below in each scripture reference.

II. What does it mean to me? (Reflective Level)

The top three sections reflect how I dialogue with the writer of the Gospel of John. This is my interpretation of the significance of John's message.
