**Gospel of Mark 6:1 to 7:30**

**As you read, recall that we approach our study of Mark by sections and not by chapters. The sections are reported in The Gospel Chart of St. Mark. This is a separate resource soon to be printed in a pdf. file related to this Gospel. (If not available now, it soon will be.)**

**I. Read Mark 6:1 to 7:30 in one reading.**

II. Note that this section of our study chart is on the topic of "The struggles of the faithful and the unfaithful." This is the last section supporting the larger topic of "The tools of power and teaching others to use them." With this in mind, reflect on the following:

6:1 - 6 Jesus is rejected at Nazareth

6:7 - 13 Sending out the Twelve Disciples

6:14 - 29 The death of John the Baptist

6:30 - 44 Feeding the 5,000

6:45 - 52 Walking on water

6:53 - 56 Heals the sick in Gennesaret

7:1 - 13 The teachings of the Ancestors

7:14 - 23 Things making people unclean

7:24 - 30 A woman's faith

III. How would you answer the peoples question in 6:vs. 2

"Where did he get all this?"

"What wisdom is this that has been given to him?"

6:vs. 6 Why was Jesus surprised because the people did not have faith?

IV. 6:vss 12 and 13 Describe the message of the 12 Disciples as they went out to preach. Be care to avoid "head trip" stuff.

V. We'll spend some time on 7:14 - 23 — "Things that make people unclean." Please read through this section and do some thinking prior to our I HOP gathering.
