**THE DEEP DRILLING FORMAT**

**This format is based on Imaginal Education principles.** Its focus is on "spatial understanding" instead of "linal understanding." Linal reading is deductive, the process of adding words, lines, paragraphs together to make the idea whole. Spatial reading is an inductive process in which the broad scope of the material is intuited, and we are allowed to enter into a dialogue with the author. To do this effectively, note the following ways to access this chart "spatially."

First: Read from the top box down. Note that each succeeding level supports and describes the level above .

Second: Observe the two boxes at the bottom. The lowest boxe ("A") are the scripture references. The little box ("B") above the scriptures are the various Biblical pericope (or sub-titles). Occasionally, you will note numbers with a small "a" beside them. This is to accommodate my mistakes in the original numbering these pericope. This material probably is useless to you, as most bible versions have differing sub-titles.

Third: The material designated "-D-" is my reflections on this chapter. Various pericope was grouped together and given a descriptive name. Each succeeding level of the reflective part of the chart groups more and more material together. The large box at the top summarizes and names the metaphor that carries the theme of this Gospel. **This is important work as it is your own dialogue with the author.**

Now, you try your own grouping and naming. It is an interesting and exciting method of grasping the significance of any material we read. It is our first way of experiencing the material. Also, it develops our intuitional skills.
