Date of composition: The exact date cannot be determined. However, it is estimated Paul wrote this letter between 55 and 59 C.E.

Observe the format: The Human Situation, God's response in Christ Jesus, and the result is embracing our work as The Church.

Key Words: "Faith" and "Righteousness." From a Gut Trip Analysis of these words, 1) "Faith" means surrender--the death--of our human existence as "being on vacation" for the meaning-filled spiritual existence of "living at home." 2) "Righteousness" is the experience in living the transformed life in spiritual liberation. This is our intended creation, the result of which is living the humane life. For Paul, righteousness and justification have the same Greek basis.
